

Application for the
Rockingham County Public Schools
No Student Left Offline Program

This program is sponsored by Rockingham County Public Schools and the Rockingham Educational Foundation. The purpose of the program is to provide a home computer with internet access for certain students who do not have access to one for assignments, research, and other educational uses. The intent of the program is to assist students who could not otherwise afford to have a computer at home for these purposes. The computers provided are older, reconditioned Macintosh computers previously used in a school setting. They will remain property of Rockingham County Public Schools. All computers have the necessary software installed so that a student can continue work on projects at home which are begun at school. The RCPS digital locker service will enable students to transfer files from school to home and vice versa.

To be eligible for this program, a student must:

- 1) be enrolled at Broadway, East Rockingham, Spotswood, or Turner Ashby High School (preference given to Grades 11, 12)
- 2) not have a working computer in the household
- 3) not be in poor school standing
- 4) have a good attendance record (absent less than 10% of days school is in session)
- 5) have a wired telephone service at home
- 6) state in the application the academic/financial needs he/she has for the use of a home computer

Students and parents must agree to:

- 1) Pick up the computer from RCPS Central Office on one of the assigned days
- 2) Connect it at home using the directions provided
- 3) Take it to Massanutten Technical Center if it needs service (this service is free)
- 4) Abide by the RCPS Acceptable Use Policy and the Highspeedlink Acceptable Use Policy while using it at home
- 5) Return it to RCPS Central Office when the student no longer meets the eligibility requirements.
Underclassmen who receive a computer may keep it over the summer.

Applications are to be turned in to the counseling office at each high school. A committee will select the participating students. Students selected will be notified of the pickup procedure.
