These are instructor facilitated online courses that are informative, fun, convenient, and highly interactive. A new section of every course begins monthly.

Course Requirements: All courses require Internet access, email, Netscape Navigator or Microsoft Internet Explorer. All courses run for six weeks with a two week grace period at the end. APPRENTICESHIP AND DIPLOMA PROGRAMS:

Apprenticeship is training for occupations commonly known as skilled crafts or trades that require a wide and diverse range of skills and knowledge, as well as maturity and independence of judgement. The apprentice and the employer enter an agreement in which the apprentice received on-the-job training in a full-time position and attends MTC a minimum of one night per week for related instruction. Most programs take between three and five years to complete. Upon completion of the on-the-job training and the curriculum, the student will receive a Journeyman card for the trade completed. An Apprentice certificate is also awarded by Massanutten Technical Center at graduation.

Diploma programs are those that anyone may register and complete. This curriculum is the same as that of the apprentice. The difference in the Diploma program from the Apprenticeship is that the student is not required to be sponsored by a company and registered with the Department of Labor. Diploma programs are set-up to be completed in a three or four year time frame depending on the amount of time a student can attend class each week. Upon completion of a diploma program, the student will receive a diploma for the trade / program completed at Massanutten Technical Centers graduation.
